Classroom Guidelines

Science

There are two basic rules:

1. Do what is expected of you.
2. Do the best that you can.

As a student, you are:

- To respect each student's right to learn.
- To come to class prepared for the day's lesson (textbook, notebook, lined and graph paper, pencil, pen, eraser, scientific calculator, 15 cm ruler and agenda book)
- To be on time.
- To have no food / drinks (Note this is a safety –inspired rule)
- To have no personal listening devices.
- To turn off cell phones.
- To complete assignments in the designated time frame.
Late homework 25% may be deducted
excessively late homework 50% may be deducted
- To complete assignments in a quality manner.
- Notebook will contain all work arranged in date assigned order, including notes, homework & labs
- To attend class on a regular basis and take responsibility for all make-up work.
- To participate in all learning activities.
- To use washroom breaks only in emergency situations, ex. Sick or bloody nose.
- To maintain an open line of communication between teacher, parent and yourself, as to questions and concerns (both academic and behavioral)

These basic guidelines will enable you to be successful in my class

If for some reason you chose to act inappropriately, any of the following may be administered as a consequence:

- Verbal warning
- Re-assignment of seating
- Parent notification
- Administrative referral
